Locally

- ◆ **PACEM—Homeless Ministry in Charlottesville.** We will be hosting this ministry January 12-19 at Frays Mill. Volunteers are needed for meals, hosting and more.
- ◆ **Tutoring**—we tutor local children at two locations during the school year. Tutoring happens on Saturdays from 11:00-1:00. We work with children on reading and math skills.
- ◆ **Tuesday's Table**—we provide a meal for this event in Stanardsville on the 2nd Tuesday of every month. Groups are always needed to help prepare a meal.
- ◆ **Habitat for Humanity** we were involved in the building of the first 2 Habitat homes in Greene County. Volunteers are always welcome.
- ◆ **English as a Second Language**—we would like to start offering these classes in 2008.
- ◆ **Operation Inasmuch**—in the spring we will partner with the Central Virginia Baptist Association (CVBA) to reach out to the Charlottesville community through acts of love.
- ◆ **International Student Ministry at UVa**—We work with our Baptist Campus Ministry to reach out to international students at UVa. We need people willing to spend one evening a month assisting with outreach activities.
- ◆ **Vacation Bible School/Backyard Bible Clubs** This is one of our largest outreach activities of the year! We need lots of volunteers to teach, smile and love children!
- ◆ **Responding to local needs**—we often work with local agencies to assist people in need
- ◆ **Youth Outreach Days**—every summer our youth ministry goes out into the community doing servant projects. Adult volunteers are needed to help!

Locally

- ◆ **Hispanic Church Plant** We hope to work with the Central Virginia Baptist Association to plant a Hispanic church in the Charlottesville area. This will need prayer support, encouragers and workers.
- ◆ **Emergent Church Plant** Plans are being made for the Virginia Baptist Mission Board and the Central Virginia Baptist Association to work together in planting a church to reach students at UVa. This will need prayer support, encouragers and workers.

State and Nation

- ◆ **Disaster Relief**—When natural disasters happen, Virginia Baptist respond with feeding units, shower units, children's crisis trailer and more. Volunteers must be trained to be able to go.
- ◆ **Operation Christmas Child**—We collect boxes every November to send to children around the world for Christmas.
- ◆ **Myrtle Beach**—work with Street Reach ministries to reach out to children and teens in this resort area.
- ◆ **Johanning Baptist Center**—spend a few days in Washington, DC working at a center that feeds and provides activities and ministry to area children.
- ◆ **Eastern Shore**—Be a part of a mission trip in August each year to reach out to Migrant Workers.
- ◆ **Family Missions Week**—July 14-19 at Eagle Eyrie in Lynchburg. Have a great week together as a family reaching out with God's love!

Internationally

- ◆ **Germany—Baptist World Alliance Youth Congress Meeting.** This trip is open to juniors and seniors in high school as well as college students. The BWA Youth Congress takes place every 5 years and this year will be occurring in Leipzig, Germany. The dates of the trip will be July 21-August 4, 2008. Before joining the Youth Congress Celebration we will spend 8-10 days on a mission experience in Germany.
- ◆ **Hosting children from Belarus**—we will partner with ABRO to host children for 6 weeks in the summer. This allows the children to get away from the radiation of Chernobyl for six months and to receive medical and dental care.
- ◆ **Medical Missions**—there are significant opportunities for people with medical skills to be on mission. Medical mission trips are often the only way to witness in some countries.
- ◆ **Philippines**—Join the Munson family on mission in the Philippines. The Munsons serve as Spring Hill missionaries. No telling what you might get into—church planting, medical missions, working with children. It will be a great adventure!
- ◆ **Uganda**—Join the Berry family in reaching out in Kampala, Uganda. The Berrys serve as Spring Hill missionaries. Their focus is on church planting and working with human relief evangelism.
- ◆ **Ukraine—Special Orphans** Be a part of working with special needs orphans providing love and training to those who work with them.
- ◆ **South Africa**—we will do a Vacation Bible School, work with an orphanage and train local teachers.
